Young Writers Creative Writing Competition 2023 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Judging: Each story is judged primarily on its creativity; consideration will also be given to its literary merit as a short story including: story structure (plot, characters, setting, and point of view), description, style, and grammar.
- 2. Entries must be the original work of the author.
- 3. Only one entry per person will be accepted. Joint entries will not be accepted.
- 4. Entries should be typed or neatly hand-written
- 5. The storyline is open, with a limit of 400 words or less and one entry per student
- 6. The competition is open to all young writers in Cottesloe, Peppermint Grove and Mosman Park, and students at local schools.

- 8. All entries must include the entrants Name, class & school, age and email address (if available). No updated or revised versions of entries will be considered after initial entry.
- 9. To ensure anonymity for judging, no authors' names should appear on the entry itself.
- 10. Entries may be retained by The Grove Library. Copyright is retained by the author.
- 11. Judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
