If your kids are voracious readers check out the tween section and reserve some fantastic reads.

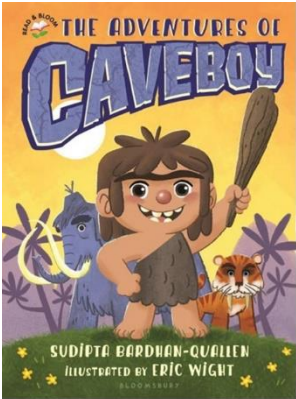

'Pick and Collect'

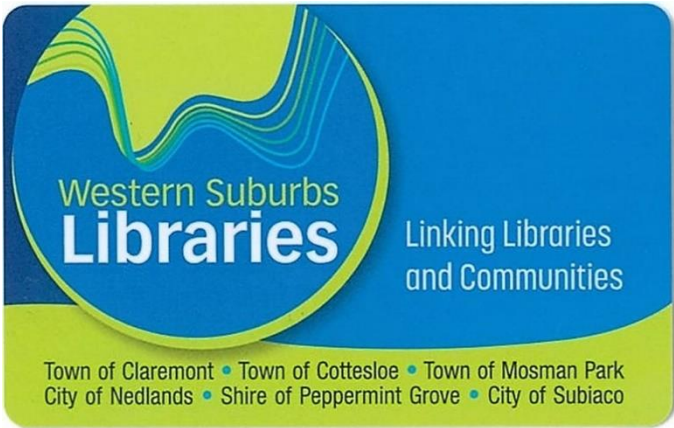
The Times are a changing at The Grove Library
